Wayan'e is a gem when it comes to variety. Be sure to go early, as Wayan'e is quite popular and tends to sell out quickly at the multiple locations. Tacos are around \$20 MXN, with tortas for \$30 MXN, making this a great spot for affordable, authentic eats.
